She spoke about the exciting new relationships with organizations such as Backbone inc. and Peoples Pride, which saw the birth of a new community event in Brisbane. 		Rae provided an update on the membership status of BURN Arts. Prior to today there were 42 members and it has received 5 or 6 new member forms today.

		In summary, the burn made a slight profit. An invoice from QPWS was received which was much more than expected. Instead of an estimated \$6,000, it was closer to \$14,000, which means we made only a few thousand instead of the forecasted \$15,000.	
		There still remains grant money (which has been allocated for the equipment originally applied for) as well as around \$7,000 that is still in the account from the previous year's burn.	
		The budget for this year was based on 300, and we ended up having 270 paid attendees, so it was a great achievement for us to still scrape by mainly due to the fact that many departments came in under budget for the year.	
		There are a few items that remain uncategorized, and Kira will follow these up with the respective participants to ensure that we can allocate budgets accordingly for the year ahead.
